

Dear Cerberus Company Store Manager,

I brought you this letter to tell you that I will no longer be shopping at your store.

Shaw's and Star Market share a parent company, Cerberus Capital Management. Cerberus also owns the Freedom Group, a gun-manufacturing conglomerate that owns about 20% of the gun industry, including Remington and Bushmaster. They manufactured the gun used in Newtown to kill 26 innocent children and teachers at the Sandy Hook Elementary School. That gun, a Bushmaster assault rifle, was also used by the D.C. Sniper and the Webster, NY shooter who shot and killed firemen as they responded to a call. That same company also manufactured the guns that were used by the Washington DC Naval Yard shooter and the San Bernardino shooter.

I can no longer shop at your store because when I shop here I feel like I'm contributing to gun violence. If Cerberus divests their interest in Freedom Group or at least publicly supports universal background checks and mandatory training, I'll be a shopper here once again. Until then, I do not want my bread and butter to contribute to blood money contributions to the NRA and its supporters in Congress.
